**ORDER / SUMMON**

This is an appeal under Section 19(3) of RTI Act, 2005 received from Shri Rakhini Mipi for non-furnishing of 15(fifteen) point information pertaining to CAMPA under Division Forest Office, Anini w.e.f 01 Jan 2015, by the PIO, o/o the DFO, Anini, Dibang Valley District as sought for by him under section 6(1) (Form-A) of RTI Act, 2005 vide his application dated 10.11.2025.

• This appeal was, accordingly, listed for 2(two) times on 20.05.2026 and 24.07.2026.

On 20.05.2026 wherein the PIO, the DFO, Shri T. Rime appeared through VC but the appellant was absent, this Commission, noticing that the First Appellate Authority (FAA), the CCF, Tezu did not consider the appeal as required under section 19(1) of the RTI Act, 2005 remanded the appeal to the FAA vide order dt.20.05.26 for adjudication and passing an appropriate order within 4(four) weeks from the date of receipt of the order with liberty to the appellant to come back to this Commission under section 19(3) of the RTI Act if he is dissatisfied or aggrieved by the decision of the First Appellate Authority.

The appellant, in terms of liberty granted to him, had approached this Commission again vide his letter dt.23.06.2026 informing that the PIO, despite the First Appellate Authority's order dt.11.06.2026, the PIO did not furnish the documents.

• In the premises as above, vide order dt. 24.06.26, this appeal was listed again on 24.07.2026 and in the meantime the PIO was directed to furnish the requested information to the appellant and report compliance thereof on 24.07.2026.

On 24.07.2026, both the appellant, Shri Rakhi Mipi and the PIO, Shri Taluk Rime are present through V.C.

• This Commission, after hearing the PIO that the appellant has requested for an indiscriminate and disproportionate information for from 2015 to till date and that many of the information are not available for the reason that the projects /schemes under CAMPA were not executed through tender but through the respective villagers and also noticing that rest of the queries pertain to over 10 (ten) financial years, directed the appellant, vide order dt.24.07.26, to prioritise his demand for the requested information/documents and also to visit the office of the PIO, if so desires, and inspect the records as is entitled to under section 2(j)(i) of the RTI Act, 2005.

The PIO was also directed to furnish the information/ or appropriate replies on an affidavit accordingly with cogent reason in respect of those not being furnished. In this regard, the PIO was also reminded of the requirement of law under section -7(8)(i) read with section-18(3)(c) of the RTI Act, 2005 and rule- 5(vi) of the AP Information Commission (Appeal Procedure) Rules, 2005.

The PIO and the appellant were, thus, directed to comply with the above direction within 1(one) month from the date of receipt of this order for further consideration of the appeal.

As directed the appellant, vide his letter dt.20.08.2026 (as reproduced below), complained that the PIO neither furnished the information nor responded to his calls and hence prayed for necessary action against the PIO.

*"Respected Sir,*

*1. Please refer to your Memo No. APIC-196/2026/779 dated 27 Jul 2026.*

*2 With due respect and humble submission, I beg to state the following lines for your favorable action please*

*3. That sir, I have submitted my RTI application to Divisional Forest Officer, Anini and sought information regarding CAMPA under Dibang Valley District. But PIO fails to provide information in time, later I have submitted my First Appellate Authority for the same, when hearing was conducted at CCFF office, Anini, PIO assured me to provide information within 15 days. After expiry of 15 days I have personally contact him but he never pick up my calls and messages.*

*4. Lastly, I have submitted the application to your good office and your good office has conducted the hearing on 24 Jul 2026, now 1 months time given by your office was expired on 26 Aug 2026. No any information was provided till date and I have several times visited the DFO Office but PIO was not available in the Office, Call him many occasions but no response, I have sent him whatsapp message and text messages too but he never entertained my calls and messages till date.*

*5. Hence, I request your good office to give strict order and take necessary action at the earliest please.*

*In anticipation of positive response from your end.*

In the premises as above, this appeal is listed again on 16.10.26 and in the mean time the PIO is directed to comply with this commission's order dt. 24.07.2026 and report the compliance thereof on the hearing date so as not to constrain this Commission to invoke the penal provisions of the RTI Act.
