ORDER

- 1). This is an appeal under Section 19(3) of RTI Act, 2005 filed by Shri Chera Taji, Village Lower Tarasso, Po/Ps Baliyan, Papum Pare District, Arunachal Pradesh, for non-furnishing of information by the PIO-cum-EE (RWD), Govt. of A.P., Rural Work Department, Papum Poma Division, Yupia, Papum Pare District, Arunachal Pradesh, as sought by the Appellant under section 6(1) of RTI Act, 2005 vide Form-A Dated 14/11/2025 regarding c/o Bridges over the rivers namely (1) Bormai river (2) Taraso river (3) Radaso river, Road from Tarajuli to U/Taraso (Radaso)-total length 19.50km, under PMGSY Scheme, District Papum Pare, Arunachal Pradesh.
- 2). **The 2nd hearing was held on 15th September 2026.** The PIO-cum-EE (RWD), Govt. of A.P., Rural Work Department, Papum Poma Division, Yupia, Papum Pare District, Arunachal Pradesh was represented by Adv. Yidik Lombi. The Appellant Shri Chera Taji was present in person.
- 3). Legal Counsel, Adv. Yidik Lombi informed the Commission that due to some other official duty, the PIO and the APIO could not attend the court hearing, so he was asked to represent them. The Legal Counsel also informed that the documents were kept ready to be furnished to the Appellant and that the Appellant could collect the information from the office.
- 4). The Commission admonished the PIO for gross violation of provisions of the RTI Act. Noncompliance of the Commission's order is tantamount to contempt of Court. The PIO was cautioned not to repeat such a mistake in future. The Commission, giving reasonable opportunity, directed the PIO to submit the prepared information to the Commission.
- 5). The PIO submitted the information on 15th September 2026 around 1430 hrs. The same was collected by the Appellant on 16th September 2026 around 1030 hrs. The Appellant was directed to go through the document and intimate his satisfaction or dissatisfaction to the Commission by 30th September 2026.

6). The next date of hearing would be decided on the basis of intimation from the Appellant. In case the Appellant failed to intimate to the Commission within ten days from the expiry of above time given to the PIO, the case would be disposed of.
