ORDER/SUMMON

This is an appeal under Section 19(3) of RTI Act, 2005 received from Shri Chera Taji for non-furnishing of 20(twenty) point information on C/O Widening & Strengthening Road from Itanagar to Jote, 20 km by the PIO, o/o the EE (PWD), Doimukh Division, Papum Pare District as sought for by him under section 6(1) (Form-A) of RTI Act, 2005 vide his application dated 14.11.2025.

This appeal was heard on 17th July, 2026 wherein the appellant, Shri Chera Taji was present in person while the PIO, Er. Shri Naresh Teli Camdir attended through V.C.

The appellant then submitted that the PIO has furnished information/documents in respect of some of the queries but information/documents against some of the queries were either not furnished or were furnished incomplete or misleading as under:

- (A) Information/Documents furnished: Query Nos. (1), (2), (3), (5), (6), (7), (8), (10), (11), (18), (19) and (20);
(B) Information furnished incomplete: Query No (12) (First and Final Bill and MB Book in respect of non-tendering work.

The PIO, while admitting that wrong information/documents were inadvertently furnished to the appellant by his sub-ordinate staff, assured to furnish the revised and corrected information to the appellant. He also assured to trace out some of the documents which, if found, will be furnished. The appellant then pleaded that appropriate direction be issued to the PIO to furnish the reasons for denial of some of the requested information on an affidavit.

This Commission, upon hearing the parties, observes that the PIO has furnished replies/documents to most of the queries of the appellant except against few queries which the PIO was directed furnish and also to furnish appropriate replies on affidavit if the o/o the PIO is not able to furnish any of the left out information, as mandated by section-7(8)(i) r/w section-18(3)(c) of the RTI Act and rule- 5(vi) of the AP Information Commission (Appeal Procedure) Rules, 2005.

The PIO was, thus, directed to comply with the above direction within 2(two) weeks from the date of receipt of order dt.17.07.26.

The appellant, vide his letter dt. 05/08/2026 (reproduced below), intimated that the PIO did not furnish the left out information despite this Commission's order and as such pleaded for an appropriate direction to the PIO.

"Respected Sir,

I most respectfully submit that I had sought certain information under the provision of the Right to Information Act 2005, from the Executive Engineer PWD Doimukh Division,

Subsequently, the matter was brought before by the Hon'ble state information commission Dated 17/08/2026. Hearing the Case No, APIC-236/2026 and the Hon'ble state information commission was pass an order directing the concerned authority to furnish the request/left information in within 14 days which was end on 31.08.2026 moreover dated on 04/08/2026 I received information from post office but I found information was incomplete asking information in form 'A' serial No. 4, 9, 12. 13. 14.15.

I therefore request Hon'ble commission direct Concerned PIO to furnish complete/left and correct information as sought in my RTI application

In view of the complaint from the appellant as above, the PIO was directed, once again, vide this Commission's order dt.17.07.2026 to furnish the left out information against queries Nos.4, 9, 12. 13. 14.15 and report the compliance therewith on 09.09.2026.

Today on 09.09.2026, the appellant, Shri Chera Taji is present in person while the PIO, Er. Naresh Teli Camdir appeared through V.C.

Heard the parties.

The PIO submitted that in compliance with this Commission's order 17.07.2026, the left out information/replies were furnished to the appellant vide letter dt.27.07.26, the copy whereof is extracted hereunder:

The appellant complained that the documents furnished by the PIO as above are not complete e.g the geotag photographs before and during the execution of the project and Measurement Book were not provided. He also complained that against his request for the 3rd party Monitoring Report, the PIO provided the report prepared by the contractor. He further complained that the PIO furnished the payment details against only 34.00 crores out of 69 crores in respect of the tendered works. The PIO, on the other hand, contended that the geotag photographs for all the stages were provided but if any left out, the same would be available in the office which will be provided to the appellant. The PIO also assured to furnish the 3rd party monitoring report, the Measurement Book and the payments details in respect of remaining tendered works.

This Commission, after hearing the parties, has arrived at the following conclusion/observations:
