**ORDER**

- 1). This is an appeal under Section 19(3) of RTI Act, 2005 filed by Shri Wangnon Wangnow, Forest Colony Longding, District Longding, Arunachal Pradesh, for non-furnishing of information by the PIO-cum-EE( RWD), Govt. of A.P., Department of Rural Work, Longding Division, District Longding, Arunachal Pradesh, as sought by the Appellant under section 6(1) of RTI Act, 2005 vide Form-A Dated 05/02/2025 regarding Road from 1.54 km point of BRTF Konnu to PMGSY Road to Konsa.
- 2). **The 4<sup>th</sup> hearing was held on 31<sup>st</sup> March' 2026.** Shri R.W. Zimik, the PIO-cum-EE (RWD), Govt. of A.P., Longding Division, Longding District, Arunachal Pradesh, and the Appellant Shri Wangnon Wangnow had appeared before the Court through video conferencing.
- 3). The Appellant informed the Commission that the information furnished by the PIO were not according to the information sought by him and implementation of the work were not according to the information furnished. The Appellant also had appealed for compensation of Rs. 40, 000/- (Rupees Forty Thousand) only for the losses he had incurred due to delay in furnishing of information by the PIO.
- 4). The PIO submitted that all the available information had been furnished to the Appellant. Moreover, the Appellant complained that he did not receive the calls, as also had not visited the office to clear the confusion and collect information. He further submitted that had the Appellant given in writing the specific queries for any lapses, the queries could have been answered.
- 5). The Commission viewed that there had been an apparent miscommunication gap between both the parties. The Commission advised the Appellant to approach the appropriate authority to complaint regarding corruption and mismanagement, if he had any proof and that the jurisdiction of the Commission was limited to facilitate flow of information to the information seekers according to the provisions of the RTI Act 2005.

6). The Commission directed the PIO to furnish call details or any other valid proof that justified the claims of the PIO within seven days from the date of issue of this order. The Commission shall wait for justification of the PIO, failing which, action would be taken according to the provisions of the RTI Act.

7). The Appellant was asked to furnish list of incomplete information, if any, to the PIO under intimation to the Commission within seven days from the date of issue of this order.

8). Next course of action shall be taken on the basis of steps taken by the PIO and the Appellant.
